

Barbara Spence of OCT very kindly recorded Iolanthe. Please let Lynda Foster know if you would like a copy of the DVD or a USB stick.

A donation of either £5 for a DVD or £10 for a USB stick would be appreciated. Both of the two performances (dress rehearsal and Friday night) will be on separate DVDs for the one price (2 for 1). The quality of the images of dress rehearsal has come out better than the Friday performance as the lighting was quite low and it goes out of focus on occasions.

As previously, the sticks will be formatted as exFAT because of the size of the files. Most recent computers should be able to read this but some smart TVs may not be able to read exFAT - it may be possible to connect a laptop to the TV to show it. The quality of the picture on the USB is better than a DVD.
